

Household Pet Emergency Shelter Functional Exercise

This course is a functional exercise of setting up and operating a temporary pet emergency shelter in a community. The goal of this course is for the user to demonstrate proficient skills for shelter site inspection, design and set up for safe and efficient household pet shelter operations while guaranteeing that all pets are properly identified, registered and linked to their owners, thus ensuring that they can be reunited if separated. Shelter operators are encouraged to make every effort to prevent separation of pets from their owners and preserve the strength of the human-animal bond.

The course does require completion of the LSART Household Pet Emergency Sheltering Course within the past 3 years.
